

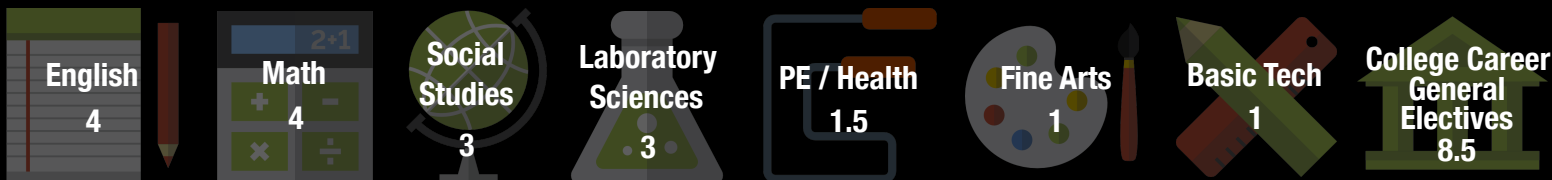
# ARUNDEL HIGH SCHOOL



Arundel High School is one of twelve high schools in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Arundel High School was originally built in 1949, and is the home of the Wildcats. It is located approximately 30 minutes from either Baltimore or Washington DC. The students live in a suburban setting surrounded by the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries. Currently, the surrounding area is going through a growth period due to its proximity to Ft. Meade, NSA and BRAC. Arundel High has been named one of the top 1200 schools in Newsweek and the Washington Post. It is a four year comprehensive high school with an enrollment of approximately 2050.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All seniors are required to earn 26 credits for graduation. These requirements include 4 credits in English, 3 credits of Social Studies (1 each in Government, World History, and US History), 4 credits of Math (including Algebra and Geometry), 3 credits of lab science (Biology must be one), 1 credit of PE, .5 credit of Health, 1 credit in Fine Art, 1 credit of Basic Technology, and 8.5 elective credits. Students must also earn required credits from their chosen college or career completer program. Arundel operates on a 4-period, A Day-B Day block schedule.

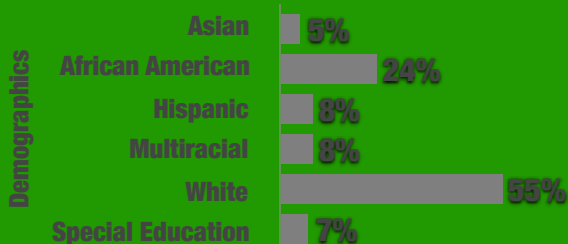

*GRADING SYSTEM*

High school course final semester grades shall be determined by averaging three percentage grades. Each of the two marking period grades of a semester shall equal 40%, and the final exam shall equal 20% of the final semester average. AP and Honors courses are so designated on the transcript. The grade point average weighting system is based on the following scale:

Class rank is determined at the end of the sixth semester (end of junior year). A final class rank is determined at the end of senior year. All students are included in the class rank, which is based on all subjects.
