**Task 2 - Wisely choose your high resolution digital device to take pictures for assignments**

What you shoot your pictures with is important. You must have a device that is minimally a 5mp camera. An IPOD won't work, but most Smartphones will. A DSLR is great but might be overkill, but a point and shoot is just fine. All devices must (except for phones) have a memory card.

**Task 3 – Sign up for a Google Email Account and download the Google Photo APP to your Smartphone.**

All images from Summer Assignments are to be stored on Google Photos inside of albums. It is a free cloud service that stores all the photos that you take on your phone or camera. How you get the photos onto the Google Photo server depends on what you are using to shoot. If you download the APP and you shoot with your phone, then you can choose to move your pics automatically via WIFI or DATA connection. If you use a camera to shoot than you manually transfer your photos thru your camera cord or card reader on your home computer. Either case, this is where you will be storing your photos through the summer and throughout the school year.

**Task 4 - Shooting Assignments**

Create a Photographic series for each of 3 themes selected from the list below. A series includes at least 6 final shots, but as always shoot with a "roll of film in mind (24)" for editing when you return to school. ALWAYS shoot with design in mind: elements and principals of design, explore camera settings

**Shooting Assignment #1 - Required: A Day in My Life**

Purpose: to capture the most ordinary of events, moments, surprises, contemplations. Carry a camera with you beginning with the moment your eyes open to the moment you close them. 100 shots minimum. Upload to Google Photos and create an album. Due 2<sup>nd</sup> day of school

**Shooting Assignment #2 - Choose 2 Themes from the list below.** Shoot at least a roll of film (24 shots) for each theme – upload unedited shots to Google Photos create an album for each theme. Due 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of School

Your peeps might not be living, doesn't matter. Learn about the lineage of photographers who influenced them.**
