Describe what you thought of each activity. A minimum of 5 French sentences and evidence of completion (ie. screen shot, photo) is required for each activity.

1. Talk to another French-speaker for 20 minutes.
2. Go to a French restaurant and complete your order in French.
3. Teach your family or friends a concept you've learned in French class.
4. Tutor another French student for 20 minutes.
5. Go shopping at a French bakery and complete your transaction in French.
6. Visit a French-speaking country.
7. Change your cell phone language to French for an entire week.
8. Change your Facebook language to French and use it for an entire hour (or all week!).
9. Follow a French-speaking actor/actress/singer on Twitter and read 20 of their most recent tweets.
10. Explore one or more French websites – 30 minutes
11. Watch 2 French-language commercials on YouTube.
12. Read 3-5 articles about famous French-speaking people on <http://www.encyclopediecanadienne.ca/fr/article/30-francophones-celebres/>
13. Research a French-speaking country. Find a hotel, activities & sights to see. Create an itinerary for a trip.
14. Create a Pinterest board related to a French or French-speaking artist.
15. Find a French games website. Play for 30 minutes.

16. Watch a French cartoon for 15 minutes & summarize.

17. Watch the French language trailer for a movie you would like to see.

18. Watch TV with the subtitles on in French for 30 min.

19. Watch an entire movie in French.

20. Watch TV on mute for 30 minutes. Narrate what's happening in French

21. Watch a documentary (English or French) about a famous native French-speaker.

22. Label 15 or more things in your home you don't already know the name for. Leave the labels for a week.

23. Read a book in French for 30 minutes.

24. Read three Bible chapters in French ([www.biblegateway.com](http://www.biblegateway.com)).

25. Read the French directions of 5 things in your house/job (like shampoo).

26. Explore the French-language section of a bookstore. Browse at least 10 books (E-books okay) and note the two that are most interesting to you.

27. Read a French-language newspaper (online newspaper is okay) for 30 minutes.

28. Read a French language blog about how the blogger celebrates something.

Compare to one of your own traditional celebrations.

29. Read and memorize a short poem in French. <http://www.learn-french-help.com/french-poems-for-children.html>

30. Find a French-language recipe online.

Make the recipe and try it!

31. Go to a play written by a French author.

32. Get together with friends in this or other French classes and speak only in French for 45 minutes.

33. Listen to a French radio station for 30 minutes.

34. Listen to French music for 45 minutes.

35. Find 5 different French food products and try them. Compare them to products from the US.

36. Play Scrabble or another game in French for 20 minutes.

37. Research a university in a French-speaking country.

38. Play [www.FreeRice.com](http://www.FreeRice.com) in French for 20 minutes.

39. Tweet in French for a week.

40. Take a virtual trip to a French museum - Le Musée d'Orsay, Le Louvre, Le Musée des Beaux Arts-Montréal.
